GRADUATION POLICY

1. Policy Statement:

AIS is committed to ensure that each student in the school is prepared to meet the academic standards in Scholastic and Co-Scholastic areas of the CBSE Curriculum to graduate in Secondary and Senior Secondary Exams.

2. Purpose:

To Establish and fulfill requirement criteria for graduation from the school in CBSE Exams, AISSE and AISSCE.

3. Pass Criteria Grade 10 (Secondary):

The students shall be registered with the CBSE in Grade 9 .Grade 10 examinations will be based on the syllabi prescribed by the board. The Examination would be conducted in theory as well as in practical depending upon the nature of the subjects and the marks/Grades allotted shall be as prescribed in the curriculum. The qualifying grade in each subject under Scholastic area A shall be minimum Grade D

4. Pass Criteria Grade 12 (senior secondary):

The qualifying marks in each subject of the board exams shall be 33% at senior secondary certificate examination .However in a subject involving practical work , a candidate must obtain 33% marks in the theory and 33% marks in the practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate, in order to qualify in that subject. (5 Subjects in Total).

5. Scheme of Examinations (Secondary and Senior Secondary)

5.1. Internal Assessment in All Subjects

The internal assessment was part of CBSE assessment system but it was not available in all the subjects. Class 12 English, Mathematics, Political Science are some examples with no internal assessment. Now, in the new scheme of assessment all the subjects will have 25% (20 Marks out of total 100) marks for internal assessment. Thus, in March 2020 exam, CBSE will conduct board exam for 80 marks only. However, some science subjects and fine arts will continue to be of 70 and 30 marks.



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5.2. Internal Choice in Question Paper

CBSE introduced internal choice in 33% questions in the year 2019. The same will continue in 2020 too. This has been extended to all the subjects. Now students will find 33% internal choice in all the sections in the question paper in all subjects. Thus, students will have plenty of options to choose the questions. This will help them to answer the question that they know better. Means, the overall difficulty level of the question paper will be reduced by 33 percent.

5.3. Objective Type questions

CBSE will put 25% objective type questions including multiple-choice questions in all the subjects. It means, there will be at least 20 Marks questions out of total 80 marks will be objective type questions. Now the subjective questions where students need to write detailed answer will carry only 60 marks. In other words, the overall 60% of assessment need to write answers in detail. Rest 40% is objective type and internal assessment.

5.4. Issue of graduation Certificate:

The result sheet shall indicate the factual position of the candidate with the marks/grades obtained by the candidate along with his/her status ie., Pass /Fail/Compartment. In respect of Senior School Certificate of Examination and Eligible for Qualifying Certificate / Qualified for admission to Higher Classes/ Eligible for Improvement of Performance.

A candidate will be eligible to get the grade sheet come Certificate of Performance in Secondary Examinations indicating the Marks and the grades obtained in the subjects under Scholastic area A scholastic area B and Co-Scholastic areas C.

5.5. Responsibilities:

The subject teachers will ensure that the lessons taught meets the standards for graduation. The principal will ensure that approved curriculum is implemented. The curriculum leaders will monitor student progress to provide feedback to students and parents by the subject teachers towards fulfillment of graduation requirements.



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5.6. MOE subjects

Arabic is optional from Grade 9-12. The Muslim students should learn Islamic studies. Grade 12 Students will appear for Unified Examination Conducted by Ministry Of Education.

The graduation of grade 10 makes it eligible for the student to join for Senior Secondary Course. The graduation of grade 12 makes it eligible for the student to join universities /Higher Education.

This policy will be reviewed annually or in accordance to the changes brought by the CBSE.
