CIRCULAR NO. 57 PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING EQUIVALENCY CERTIFICATE FOR POST-GRADUATE STUDIES

Dear Students and Parents,

Greetings!

As our Grade 12 students prepare for the next stage of their academic journey, we aim to provide a smooth process for obtaining necessary documents for university admission. Please follow the steps outlined below to ensure that all requirements are met in a timely manner.

Steps to Follow:

- 1. Research University Requirements
 - o Understand the university interests of the student.
 - Visit university websites for detailed information on admission and application documents required.
- 2. Identify ADEK Services via TAMM

After reviewing the university requirements, determine which of the following services provided through ADEK's TAMM platform are needed:

- Attested School Report Card
 After the release of the final marks, request an attested school report card through TAMM.
- School Completion Certificate
 Request a 'To Whom It May Concern' school completion certificate indicating successful completion of secondary school.
- Attested Sequential Study Transcript
 Request an attested sequential study transcript, showing academic progression in private school.
- 3. Ensure All Obligations Are Fulfilled

Before proceeding, ensure the following:

- All fees are cleared.
- o Any outstanding equipment (e.g., laptops) is returned.

4. Additional Steps Based on University Requirements:

Requirement	Action
	If required by the university, obtain a printed copy of the school diploma and submit for attestation at ADEK's Customer Happiness Center.
Equivalency Certificate (UAE)	If studying in the UAE, apply for the Equivalency Certificate to verify that qualifications meet the Ministry of Education's standards.
Equivalency Certificate (Outside UAE)	If studying outside the UAE, apply for the Equivalency Certificate via the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MOFAIC).

5. Additional Attestation Requirements

 For students planning to study abroad, an attestation from the embassy of the host country may also be required. Please verify this with your selected university.
